This agreement is not intended to be a legally binding contract between us and can be cancelled at any time at the discretion of either party.

This agreement is to be read in conjunction with the Association's Stewards and Volunteers handbook.

Our commitment to you:

- To introduce you to how the Association works and your role in it and to provide any training which may be required;
- to provide regular contact with a named volunteer manager so that we can manage your volunteering activities and you can provide feedback;
- to utilise your skills, value your volunteering time and acknowledge individual needs wherever possible.
- to provide suitable refreshments while volunteering where applicable;
- to consult with you and keep you informed of changes which may affect your volunteering role;
- to insure you against injury you suffer or cause due to negligence;
- to provide a safe workplace;
- to apply our equal opportunities policy;
- to address any concerns you raise.

Our expectation of you as a volunteer:

As a Royal Norfolk Agricultural Association volunteer you are in a position of trust. We ask you:

- To work reliably to the best of your ability, and to give as much warning as possible whenever you cannot meet your volunteering commitments;
- to follow the Royal Norfolk Agricultural Association's policies, procedures and conditions as laid out in the Steward and Volunteer Handbook:
- to uphold the values and standards of the Association;
- to maintain good relations with other volunteers, staff and Association members;
- to carry out your role safely, for the sake of yourself and others;
- to promote the Association to visitors;
- to maintain confidentiality.
