LIVESTOCK GENERAL INFORMATION

1. SITE

The Show will be held on the Norfolk Showground, Dereham Road, Costessey, Norwich, NR5 0TT, 5 miles west of Norwich, just off the A47 Norwich Southern By-Pass at the A1074 junction (Longwater Interchange). **Please use all appropriate entrances, as signed off the main roads closer to the Showground.**

2. ENTRIES & STALLS/PENNING

Entry Fees are as stated beneath each section heading. Stall/penning fees are as stated in the information prior to each livestock section. **Entries and stalls/penning MUST be booked ONLINE at www.royalnorfolkshow.co.uk. Late entries will NOT be accepted and entries in all sections will be subject to space and availability.**

3. ACCOMMODATION

Exhibitors: A list of convenient Hotels, B&Bs, etc. can be found on our website.

Caravans: Caravan Passes priced **£35 incl. VAT** are available in the designated livestock areas but please be aware that space is very limited and will be allocated on a first come first served basis. **Please note** - there are no electric hook-ups in any of the caravan parks. In the interest of comfort and convenience for all exhibitors, the use of generators to provide power to caravans is not permitted between the hours of 10pm and 6am.

Showers and Toilet Facilities: These are available in St. Walstans Hall.

Stock Attendants: Private Cubicles are available for **£25 incl. VAT**. These are for one person only, in a permanent building, with a fitted bunk. Exhibitor to provide their own bedding. Doors to cubicles are to be secured by individual padlocks provided by the exhibitor. Cubicles are limited and will be allocated on a first come, first served basis.

Catering: St. Walstans Hall will offer a range of hot and cold food and refreshments. A fully equipped bar will be open until late on both Tuesday and Wednesday evening.

4. STRAW

For Cattle, Sheep, Goats & Pigs, straw will be provided. The RNAA or any of its representatives will not be held responsible for any consequential, or other loss, injury or damage done to, or occasioned by, the supply of straw.

5. ARRIVAL & DEPARTURE OF LIVESTOCK

Cattle will be admitted to the Showground during show week from Midday on Monday. Other Livestock will be admitted to the Showground during show week on Tuesday. Arrival and departure times are stated beneath section or breed headings and failure to observe the appointed times may result in elimination from classes and withdrawal of prize money. Access to the Showground will be severely restricted and will be limited only to vehicles displaying a current RNAA livestock pass or other appropriate pass. All exhibitors/attendants of livestock and/or their representatives will need to wear an appropriate wristband.

6. INSTRUCTIONS, TICKETS, VEHICLE PASSES etc

Full instructions, admission wristbands, vehicle passes etc. will be issued to all exhibitors approximately 2 weeks prior to the Show. The quantity of vehicle passes that each exhibitor receives will depend on the number of entries/bookings. Support vehicle passes will be supplied where multiple vehicle passes are requested. Please see tables on opposite page: **IMPORTANT - VEHICLE PASSES MUST BE CLEARLY DISPLAYED IN YOUR WINDSCREEN TO GAIN GATE ACCESS INTO THE SHOWGROUND. WRISTBANDS MUST ALSO BE WORN. ANY VEHICLE WITHOUT A DISPLAYED PASS AND EXHIBITORS WITHOUT A WRISTBAND WILL BE REFUSED ENTRY.**

Whilst it is understood that young handlers need wristbands for the duration of the show and will be provided with these if entered into young handler classes, other stock attendants beyond this must purchase extra wristbands. Valid for both days of the Show, these can be purchased at the cost of **£31 incl. VAT each**. **Please Note** - exhibitors are asked to check that their allocation of tickets is correct on immediate receipt of their ticket pack. **QUERIES RELATING TO TICKET/PASS ALLOCATION WILL NOT BE RESOLVED AFTER FRIDAY 19 JUNE 2026.** No duplicate tickets or passes will be issued during the Show period free of charge. **All individuals entering**

the Showground, including the drivers of any livestock trailers, equipment etc, must have a valid entrance ticket or pass or will be required to pay the full price of admission at the entrance to the Show.

7. CANCELLATION OF CLASSES/ENTRIES

The Royal Norfolk Agricultural Association reserves the right to refuse or cancel any entry, class or section it deems fit. In which case, entry fees (exclusive of any levy payments) may be returned to each exhibitor after the Show.

8. REFUNDS

Please Note: There will be no refunds for entry fees or pen/stall fees booked with the Association office. Written requests may be considered if accompanied by a relevant vet certificate but no consideration will be given to this until AFTER the Royal Norfolk Show 2026. Certificates must be on official headed notepaper and must clearly state the date, the name of both the exhibitor and the ear tag number of the entered animal. Refunds will only be considered if the ticket pack and full contents are returned unused. Refund requests (& supporting documentation) must be received into the Show Office by latest TWO WEEKS after the end of the Show. If a refund request is upheld, the refund will be made to the name under which the entries or penning were booked, less a £5 administration fee per transaction. There will be no refund on any Levies (First Aid) or any administration charges relating to payment. In the event of a notifiable disease outbreak, the refund policy will be reviewed and communicated accordingly.

9. SAFETY & WELFARE

The RNAA would like to remind you that it is your responsibility to ensure that all animals are show trained and that all your show equipment is in good condition. Exhibitors must be wearing the correct show dress required to enter the show rings. **Please be responsible.**

10. PRIZE MONEY & PREMIUMS

Prize monies and premiums will be available to claim via your Royal Norfolk Show eNet account, within 6 weeks of the Show, only once all results have been checked and verified by the appropriate breed societies. You will receive an email with instructions when this is ready to claim.

11. TROPHIES

1. ALL trophies will be presented in the appropriate Livestock, Equine, Grand Ring and Tradestand areas during both days of the show.
2. Trophies will not be engraved.
3. Trophies will not be given to exhibitors to keep in their possession for the show year.
4. If an exhibitor has a strong desire to display their trophy, they must apply in writing following the show but by the end of July and pay a £100 holding deposit.
 - a. If the application is approved the exhibitor will be allowed to collect the trophy from the show office. Trophies will not be posted to the exhibitor.
 - b. Trophies must be returned at the exhibitors cost by the end of March the following year.
 - c. Once the trophy has been returned and the condition of the trophy has been checked and approved the exhibitor will be refunded their £100 deposit.
 - d. Should any imperfections or damages be noted the deposit will not be refunded and additional repair charges may be billed to the exhibitor.

12. DEFRA REGULATION

Exhibitors should be aware and conform to the regulations in place by DEFRA at all times, including Bluetongue. A refund will be issued to an exhibitor should DEFRA regulations prevent the exhibitor from attending the Show after they have placed their entries.

13. FURTHER INFORMATION

CATTLE

Please also see Show Regulations at the end of the Prize Schedule

1. RESPONSIBILITY

- a. Please ensure you are aware of DEFRA information regarding cattle movements and health regulations. It is your responsibility to keep up to date with any change of policies/legislation, etc.
- b. Please be aware at all times that there will be pedestrians in the livestock area. All livestock exhibitors must ensure that they have adequate public liability insurance cover. All exhibitors are responsible for the observance, by themselves, their employees and their representatives or contractors of all Health and Safety at Work regulations.
- c. **Smoking is not permitted in any of the livestock lines and neighbouring areas.**

2. ENTRIES

- a. The closing date of entries is **Wednesday 3 June 2026**. All entries in all sections will be subject to space, accommodation and availability. All stock handlers will be expected to wear the correct dress whilst showing their animals in any of the show rings.
- b. Every animal entered for competition **MUST** be the property of the exhibitor and the passport **MUST** be in the name of the exhibitor otherwise the animal will be rejected. An exhibitor wishing to enter an animal in joint ownership may do so, provided the animal is registered in the names of the joint owners, and each person's name must appear on the registration certificate, otherwise the animal will be rejected. All Transfer of Ownership documentation must be completed and registration certificates updated by the Breed Society and in the possession of the exhibitor on arrival at the Showground. An animal arriving without a valid certificate, duly updated, will be rejected.
- c. Every animal entered for competition must be entered or accepted for entry in the Herd Book of its breed in this country, unless otherwise specified in the special conditions for each section.
- d. Exhibitors will be required to pay the appropriate class entry fees including fees for calf classes, and also any extra standings for equipment, as well as reserve the required number of standings needed for cattle by the entry closing date.
- e. Pedigree information, date of birth and where necessary, calving dates must be submitted when making your entries.
- f. Exhibitors will be required to complete and display above each cattle standing, a card giving details of the animal. Pedigree information will not be printed in the catalogue. Cards are available from cattle commentary box upon request.
- g. **The Showground Holding Number is 28/207/8107**. This information will be required for completion of cattle passports for any cattle born after 1 July 1996. All cattle **MUST BE** accompanied to and from the Show by their Cattle Passport.

3. BIO-SECURITY REQUIREMENTS

TB

- a. Exhibitors are required to comply with current TB regulations. PLEASE READ! For those cattle coming from ONE YEAR ONLY TB testing parishes please note that it is required that all cattle, except calves under 42 days of age are tested within 60 days (from the date of the injection, which is day zero of the 60-day period) before this show. These requirements apply to any exhibitor involved in radial testing. Compliance with the pre-movement testing requirements is the responsibility of the owner/cattle keeper moving the animal(s).
- b. If you are coming from a ONE YEAR ONLY testing parish you **MUST** provide a pre-movement test with a negative result for all cattle. Calves born on or before the 11 May 2026 MUST be pre-movement tested in order to comply with the 42-day testing rule. A copy of the negative test result **MUST** be submitted with your entries by **Wednesday 3 June**. If your test takes place after this date, you must submit your negative test result no less than 7 days prior to your arrival to the Showground. Your ticket pack will **NOT** be posted until we have received your negative test result. A copy of the certificate must also be available for inspection during the Show.

BOVINE VIRAL DIARRHOEA (BVD)

- c. Exhibitors entering cattle including calves will be required to demonstrate that either individual animals have been tested for the presence of the BVD virus (with negative results) or that the animal originates or resides in a herd accredited BVD free on a CHeCS approved cattle scheme.
- d. Proof will require a copy of a relevant laboratory report (including 'Tag and Test') or details of a BVD scheme membership.
- e. These documents must be submitted to the show office by 3 June 2026 or no less than 7 days prior to the arrival at the showground.
- f. A copy of proof documents must be available for inspection during the show.

BRUCELLOSIS

- g. Cows or Heifers which show any signs of calving or aborting, or which have any signs of abnormal discharge, will be placed into isolation and returned to the herd of origin as soon as practicable. Where an animal calves prematurely or aborts, the Divisional Veterinary Office must be informed immediately.
- h. Cattle entries will only be accepted from herds which are Fully Accredited within the Brucellosis schemes, and not subject to any restrictions imposed under The Tuberculosis Order 1964 (as amended) and The Brucellosis (England & Wales) Order 1981 as amended. In addition the entered animals must not themselves be under individual restrictions.

4. ELIGIBILITY

- a. No bull three years of age and upwards on the closing date for entries shall be eligible to compete for any prize unless it has sired at least three living calves, born within twelve months previous to that date.
- b. All cows and heifers shall be entitled to compete in the class for which they are eligible on the first day of the Show, i.e., dependent upon their calving date.
- c. Any artificial contrivance or device of any description found on, or proved to have been used on, an animal at any time whilst that animal is on the Showground, either for preventing the flow of milk or for any other improper purpose, will disqualify that animal from being awarded a Prize, and any Prize awarded prior to discovery will be forfeited. The owner of said animal may be prohibited from again entering Stock at any further show. The phrase 'artificial contrivance or device' includes blistering, bandaging or boarding of udders, setting of teats, and generally any other practice which results in the animal being shown other than in a natural state. The RNAA reserves the right to have all animals inspected by the Official Veterinary Officers either prior to, during or after judging or at any other time they so wish.
- d. The use of blacking, or other colouring matter, except on the feet, on cattle is prohibited. Infringement of this Regulation will render the animal in question liable to be disqualified.
- e. Any behaviour contrary to the Breed Society rules or regulations shall disqualify the animal and the exhibitor shall be dealt with in accordance with Regulation 25 printed in the Prize Schedule.
- f. All cows and heifers in milk shall be milked at the appropriate times. On the judging day, the judge may require any animal to be milked in his presence, so that he may be able to form an opinion of the udder after milking.
- g. Exhibitors of cattle entered in classes subject to qualifying yields must ensure their cattle have achieved the appropriate standards. The RNAA may request, by random selection, the verification of qualifying yields by production of NMR certificate before prizes are paid. In any class in which a condition of entry relates to yields, the qualifying date shall be 31st March in the year of the Show unless the Breed Society's regulations state otherwise.

5. WELFARE

- a. All exhibitors must ensure that they comply fully with The 2007 EU Welfare in Transport Regulation (EC) No. 1/2005.
- b. Animals shall not be considered fit for transport if they:
 - i. Are unfit animals (see DEFRA website Annex 1 Chapter 1 of Council Regulation 1/2005).
 - ii. Are pregnant female animals that have reached the latest stage of gestation (within 10% of the estimated time of the gestation before birth) and for a period of one week after giving birth.
 - iii. Are very young animals except if the journey is less than 100 km, e.g. calves of less than 10 days of age.
 - iv. Calves of less than 14 days of age on journeys exceeding 8 hours will not be permitted.

6. BULLS

- a. All bulls over one year old must have ring(s) properly fitted in the nose, and the exhibitors shall be held responsible for the safe control of the animal by suitable halter, nose chain, blinkers, leading poles etc. as appropriate.
- b. Exhibitors must provide two experienced handlers during showing and all parades. The second handler may be at the head or the rear of the bull at the discretion of the exhibitor.

7. MILKING

- a. A vacuum line will be provided at the Milk Depot. Exhibitors must provide their own bucket units.
- b. The Association is committed to meeting the terms of 'Welfare of the Dairy Cow' Code of Practice. Exhibitors are expected to ensure that they maintain the high standards of the Code of Practice. Antibiotics and other inhibiting substances are banned at the Royal Norfolk Show unless they are administered under the supervision of the Show's Veterinary Officer. Any person milking animals with open cuts on hands or arms must keep these covered with a waterproof dressing. All involved must bring and wear clean washable overalls.
- c. Cows must be milked in the Milking Parlour where facilities are provided for machine milking. The washing down of cattle at the milking points is prohibited. Clipping is also prohibited in the milking parlour.

8. CLASSES

- a. Sections & Classes may be amalgamated/cancelled at the discretion of the Head Steward if insufficient animals come forward. Stewards may, if necessary, split any class, if oversubscribed, by date of birth.

9. HEALTH AND SAFETY

- a. Electrical Safety - Any exhibitor who brings electrical equipment to the Showground must ensure that it is in good order and has been inspected and tested by a competent electrician within the past 6 months, with relevant label. The use of sub-standard equipment is strictly forbidden.
- b. Exhibitors and stockpersons should be aware of their obligations to the safety of the general public at all times whilst on the Showground and must comply with any instructions from Officials or Stewards in respect of the use of the designated cattle walkways, crossing points etc.
- c. For safety reasons, children under the age of thirteen (except those entered in the Young Handlers Competition), will not be allowed to lead animals or accompany exhibitors into the Grand Ring whilst the Grand Parade is taking place.
- d. An exhibitor, their handler or any other representative of the exhibitor or member of the general public who conducts themselves in an improper or offensive manner, to any Judge, Steward or Official appointed by the RNAA, will be reported to the Chief Executive Officer/Charity Manager. They may be refused entry to the Showground and may not be allowed to compete in any class/es or competition/s that they may have entered and any money due to this exhibitor/representative of any company may be withheld. Entry into any further Shows may also be refused.

10. ACCOMMODATION

- a. Cattle standings are priced at **£10** each.
- b. All cattle entered for the Show will be allocated a standing, either within the permanent buildings or in the marquees to the rear of the buildings. This allocation is to accommodate the judging ring plan and any particular requests received from exhibitors to allow for multiple breed entries, sharing of equipment, labour etc. All animals in one breed and one ownership will stand together so far as disease restrictions and space permit.
- c. It is strictly forbidden for any exhibitor to move from their allocated standings or to alter any other exhibitor's standings without the permission of the Head Cattle Steward. Any exhibitor who moves standings without permission may be asked to remove their cattle from the showground and will not be refunded any entry fee/s or other money due to them.
- d. Due to the expected high demand for cattle stands the Association reserves the right to reduce the number of Equipment Stands booked if necessary.

11. STRAW

- a. Straw will be provided in each shed before arrival, additional straw will be available.

12. ARRIVAL AND DEPARTURE

- a. Cattle will be admitted to the Showground during show week from 12 Midday on Monday. All cattle must arrive by 5pm at the latest on Tuesday and may depart after 4.30pm on Thursday.

13. PRIZES AND ROSETTES

- a. All classes will have rosettes provided as stated in breed section details.
- b. Prize money will be paid as printed under each breed section.

14. DEFRA REGULATION

- a. Exhibitors should be aware of and conform to the regulations in place by DEFRA at all times, including with regard to Bluetongue, which can change quickly.

Conditions:

- i) See General Conditions at the front of the Cattle Section.
- ii) All entries must be registered with the appropriate Breed Society.
- iii) Should there be insufficient entries in the Holstein, Ayrshire or Jersey sections and classes are amalgamated, conditions iv-vi will apply
- iv) Holsteins must be registered in the Herd Book proper of Holstein UK, or Classes B or C of their Supplementary Register.
- v) Ayrshires must be registered in the Ayrshire Cattle Society Herd Book and be at least 51% Ayrshire blood. If Black and White in colour, animals must be registered in the Herd Book's Full Pedigree Ayrshire section and be 100% Ayrshire blood. Percentages are shown on all registration certificates.
- vi) Jerseys must be registered in the Herd Book or Supplementary Register of UK Jerseys.
- vii) British Friesians must be at least 87.5% pure.
- viii) Dairy Shorthorn exhibitors must be members of the Shorthorn Society of UK & Ireland. All cattle must be registered in Coates's Herd Book, be of Shorthorn colour and contain a minimum of 25% Shorthorn Blood.
- ix) A team consisting of the Best Breed Pair and Group of any breed represented in this section to enter the Supreme Interbreed Championship Classes.
- x) To enable this section to run, a minimum of 3 exhibitors or 9 animals from 2 exhibitors is required. If there are insufficient numbers the section may be amalgamated. Exhibitors will be notified in advance of the Show if sections will be amalgamated.

SHOW REGULATIONS FOR EXHIBITORS

Exhibitors should also read the **General Information and Additional Conditions** at the beginning of their relevant sections.

1. NO ENTRY SHALL BE ACCEPTED UNLESS:

- a. It is made in a proper manner using the official online entries system and complies in every respect with these regulations and any conditions that may be specified.
- b. The appropriate fee(s) as specified in the Prize Schedule are paid in full by the entry closing date. No fee(s) for which a receipt has been issued by the Show Office are returnable except under Regulations 6 (Refuse or Cancel) and 9 (Amalgamation).

2. ENTRIES IN CLASSES

- a. All Classes are open except where otherwise stated in the Prize Schedule. Classes and Special Prizes restricted to a Norfolk exhibitor are open only to animals owned by an exhibitor occupying land and/or premises in Norfolk, on which the animal has lived for at least three months up to the date of the Show.
- b. The same animal may be entered in more than one class where eligible.

3. DATA PROTECTION (GDPR)

- a. All data given upon entry of all classes to the RNAA may be provided to various Breed Societies and etc for checking eligibility and publication of results. Please refer to our website rnaa.org.uk/privacy-policy for our full Privacy Policy statement.
- b. By providing data you are giving permission for that data to be stored on RNAA systems and databases.

4. CHAMPIONSHIP & SPECIAL PRIZES

An animal that is individually entered in and eligible for an appropriate class in the Prize Schedule may compete without payment of further fee for any Championship or Special Prize for which it is eligible subject to the following conditions:

- a. A Championship Prize, under that heading in the Prize Schedule, shall be for the Best Exhibit or the Best Male or Female of one breed or, where applicable, of more than one breed, or the Best Inter-breed Group of animals. Entry for a Championship Prize is automatic and is not required on the entry form.
- b. **Prize Money will be withheld if prize winning animals fail to come forward in the Championships, Special Classes or Parades for which they qualify.**

5. CORRECTNESS OF ENTRY

- a. Every exhibitor will be held responsible for the correctness of their entry. If, when called upon to prove its correctness, they fail to do so, the entry in question will not be accepted or if already accepted may be cancelled or the exhibit may be disqualified and any award to it cancelled.
- b. If it shall be proved to the satisfaction of the Council, whose decision shall be final, that an exhibitor or competitor has quoted an incorrect date or has attempted to obtain a prize by any other unfair means the matter shall be dealt with under Regulation 25 (Penalties etc).

6. RIGHT TO REFUSE OR CANCEL ENTRY

- a. The Association may refuse any entry, or cancel any entry already accepted, without any reason for doing so and reserves the right to refuse entries from any person who is under exclusion or suspension by any Breed, Livestock or Show organisation.
- b. Whenever, under this Regulation, an entry is refused or cancelled, or an exhibit is refused admission or removed, the fees paid for any such exhibit may, at the discretion of the Council, be refunded and, if refunded, shall be accepted by the exhibitor or intending exhibitor in full satisfaction of all claims against the Association.

7. OWNERSHIP OF EXHIBITS

- a. All exhibits must be bona fide property of the owner, whose name appears in the Show catalogue on the date appointed for the reservation of standings and pens and the closing of entries, and must remain in that ownership at the date of the Show, excepting only, as may be provided for in the Rules of any breed society or similar body, by which the classes are decreed to be regulated.
- b. An owner shall furnish proof of his bona fide ownership if called upon to do so, and if he/she fails to satisfy the Council he/she shall be disqualified from receiving any prize. In the event of death of an owner between the date of entry and the date of the show the executors or personal representatives of the deceased will be deemed to be the owners.

8. AGE AND PEDIGREE OF EXHIBITS

- a. The pedigree and date of birth of each animal must be stated, where required on the appropriate entry form, except that in the case of horses (other than foals) and sheep the year of birth only is required and in the commercial pig classes no date of birth is required.
- b. In case of doubt or protest, a certificate of age issued by one of the RNAA's appointed Veterinary Inspectors may be called for, and the decision of that Inspector shall be final. Where necessary, the age of an exhibit will be calculated to the first day of the Show, and any reference to months of age shall relate to calendar months.

9. CANCELLATION OR AMALGAMATION OF CLASSES/RING CHANGES

- a. The Council reserves the right to cancel any class or to amalgamate any classes. Where classes are cancelled any entry fees paid will automatically be refunded.
- b. If a ring change is required competitors will be notified in their packs. Rings are allocated based on the number of equine entries and to meet the requirements of the class to ensure the best possible showing conditions.

10. ARRIVAL AND ACCOMMODATION OF EXHIBITS

- a. Exhibitors are responsible to ensure that all stock are placed and secured in the accommodation provided. The stalling of the stock will be deemed to confirm the exhibitor's approval of the adequacy and safety of the accommodation to secure the stock.
- b. All livestock must be on the Showground before their appointed time on Tuesday before the Show, as written in individual conditions. All livestock must be in their place at 8am on the first day of the Show, unless otherwise stated in the Prize Schedule.
- c. Where accommodation is provided, either automatically or at the exhibitor's request, stock must stand in the boxes, stalls or pens, in accordance with the number allotted and displayed. Any exhibitor found guilty, either personally or through their stock assistants, of entering or taking possession of a box, pen or stall, or of interfering with the numbers erected on boxes, stalls or pens without the written authority of the Chairman of the Show Committee, will be liable to the cancellation of all their entries at the Show, may forfeit any prize money won and be dealt with in accordance with Regulation 25 (Penalties etc).

11. REMOVAL OF HORSE BOXES, VANS, CRATES ETC.

- a. All horse boxes and livestock vehicles shall be parked in the empties parks or authorised parking positions on arrival, or immediately after unloading of stock. **No vehicle may be left standing within the Showground, its avenues or stock lines.**
- b. Any exhibitor who either personally, or through anyone acting on their behalf, fails to comply with vehicle parking regulations or the directions of the stewards will be liable to the cancellation of their entries and risks forfeiting any prize money.

12. ANIMAL HEALTH

- a. Details of relevant Animal Health Regulations are contained within this Prize Schedule. In all classes, animals must be free from clinical signs of disease, injury or physical abnormality.
- b. Animals suffering from any form of infectious or contagious disease, including ringworm or any other form of infectious or contagious skin ailment, must not be brought to the Show.
- c. All exhibitors must ensure that they comply fully with The 2007 EU Welfare in Transport Regulation (EC) No. 1/2005.
- d. The Royal Norfolk Agricultural Association expects all exhibitors to observe best practice at all times.
- e. Mammals shall not be considered fit for transport if they:
 - i) Are unfit animals (see DEFRA website Annex 1 Chapter 1 of Council Regulation 1/2005).
 - ii) Are pregnant female animals that have reached the latest stage of gestation (within 10% of the estimated time of the gestation before birth) and for a period of one week after giving birth.
 - iii) Are very young animals except if the journey is less than 100 km, e.g. calves of less than 10 days of age, pigs less than 3 weeks of age and lambs of less than one week.
 - iv) Calves of less than 14 days of age on journeys exceeding 8 hours will not be permitted.

13. VETERINARY EXAMINATION

- a. All livestock may be inspected by one of the RNAA's appointed Veterinary Inspectors, who are authorised to exclude any animal from the Showground or place in quarantine, if in the opinion of that official, it is affected with any complaint or disease which is likely to prove dangerous to other animals.
- b. The Veterinary Inspector shall give a certificate of the reason for such action to the person in charge of the animal and the exhibitor shall be liable to pay to the RNAA up to £50 for liquidated damages for each animal, if more than one. It is a condition of entry that the RNAA's Veterinary Officers may, on their own authority, give such emergency treatment as they may consider appropriate in the event that the owner or his/her representative cannot be found. Exhibitors will be liable to pay for all drugs/treatment used by the RNAA's Veterinary Officers in the treatment of their animals.
- c. **Passports:** An equine passport, containing an up-to-date vaccination (equine influenza) record, must accompany every horse (including ponies, donkeys and other equine) attending The Royal Norfolk Show. Random checks by The Association's Veterinary Officers will be made before and during the Show.

14. MALPRACTICES

- a. Any artificial contrivance or device of any description found on or proved to have been on/in an animal at any time, either for preventing the flow of milk or for any other improper purpose, will disqualify that animal from being awarded a prize and the owner of the animal may be prohibited from entering stock at future events.
- b. The term 'improper practice' shall be held to include, setting of teats and generally any other practice which results in the animals being shown other than in a natural state, and the RNAA reserves the right to have all animals inspected by the Senior Veterinary Officer either prior to, during or after judging or at any other time whilst on the Showground.

15. JUDGING AND AWARDS

- a. The Judges are instructed to withhold any Prize where the entry is not of sufficient merit, and in awarding prizes in pedigree classes, to decide according to the relative merits of the animals for breeding purposes.
- b. The Council reserves the right to substitute other Judges for those announced in the Prize Schedule or to make additional appointments.

16. JUDGING AND IMPARTIALITY

- a. The RNAA seeks to ensure that all its exhibitors are judged fairly and that there is no bias or favouritism. This is only achievable if owners, producers, riders, handlers and judges consider and observe the following rules.
- b. An animal may not be exhibited in a class or final where the animal or its owner, producer, rider or handler has one of the following, or similar, connections with the judge as listed below.
- c. If the animal has been under the ownership or production of any person for whom the judge, his/her partner or business partner has provided or obtained livery or had any other connection (business or otherwise) in the 12 months prior to the Show.
- d. If the animal is or has been owned, bred, produced, trained or exhibited by the judge, a relative, business partner or partner.
- e. If the animal is owned or produced by a person from whom the judge has purchased animals or to whom he/she sold animals in the 12 months prior to the Show in which he/she is judging.
- f. Also, no pony will be eligible for the final if the breeder or previous owners will be judging the final.
- g. **Note:** The definition of a Professional Producer/Trainer is: A person who undertakes the preparation and/or production of animals belonging to other exhibitors for the show ring including at a show. A producer is someone who has an animal on their yard to show for the client and therefore has a financial interest.
- h. **The onus is on the exhibitor** to consider any connections they may have with the judge and stand down in any class, championship or final where they and other exhibitors may consider them showing under a particular judge to be a non-professional association.

17. PROTESTS

- a. Any person wishing to make a protest shall do so in writing, and lodge it at the RNAA's Office with a deposit of £50. If, on investigation the protest is not sustained to the satisfaction of the RNAA's Chief Executive Officer or an officer nominated to act on his behalf, the deposit may be forfeited to the funds of the Association.
- b. A protest must be lodged before 6pm on the day of the occurrence to which it relates. Protests concerning a prize or award must be lodged within two hours of the award being made. Out of time protests will not be considered unless a satisfactory reason for the delay can be established.

18. AWARDS AND ROSETTES

- a. No animal will be allowed to wear rosettes or ribbons other than those issued by the Association and awarded at the current year's Show.
- b. In the case of any protest, whereby any prize animal becomes disqualified, the winner of the next succeeding prize in that Class, or the animal placed reserve for any Championship or Special Prize shall take the prize that had been awarded to such disqualified animal and the lowest prize in the class shall go to the reserve number, if any.
- c. In all cases where prizes are offered or awarded conditionally, they may be withheld until the exhibitor shall have proved to the satisfaction of the Council that the conditions have been complied with.

19. CONDUCT OF EXHIBITORS AND THEIR STOCK ATTENDANTS

- a. No one will be allowed in Judging Rings whilst livestock is being judged except Officials of the Association and those in charge of exhibits. People in charge of exhibits must be suitably attired and are not permitted to smoke, drink, eat or chew when in a judging ring.
- b. Exhibitors or their Stock attendants may not light cooking stoves on the Showground, nor create any circumstances which may result in the outbreak of fire, for which they will be held responsible. The unauthorised offer of goods for sale in the livestock lines, vehicle parks or anywhere else on the Showground is strictly forbidden, and will automatically disqualify any entries from all concerned.
- c. An exhibitor or his/her handler who is responsible for an infringement of the regulations or misconduct, or any exhibitor or member of the general public who conducts himself/herself in an improper or offensive manner, to any Judge, Member of Council, Steward or official appointed by the Association will be reported to the Chief Executive Officer/Show Director. He/she may be refused entry to the Showground and may not be allowed to compete in any class or competition that he/she may have entered for the show or possibly any future Shows.
- d. **CONDUCT AND DISCIPLINE** - The RNAA will not condone any form of abusive behaviour whatsoever; in or outside of the show ring before, during or after the event: this includes intimidation, bullying, harassment and any form of communication that is deemed to be aggressive, damaging or inappropriate to judges or fellow exhibitors. Any Competitor found to be under the influence of drugs or intoxicated whilst in the ring will be disqualified from the competition and asked to leave the ring.

20. PARADES AND DISPLAY

- a. It is a condition of entry that all prize-winning animals will be paraded, shown or displayed in accordance with these Regulations, the programme of events, and the instructions of the Chairman of the Executive and Stewards. **Prize money will be withheld if prize winning animals fail to parade when required to do so.**

21. PEOPLE IN CHARGE OF EXHIBITS

- a. **Exhibitors of Livestock shall provide an adequate number of people to take charge of his or her stock while at the Show** and one person for each animal during Judging or a Parade. These individuals shall be competent in the management of the stock and conscious of the exhibitor's responsibility and liability for any accident or injury caused by the stock, and the failure to exercise adequate control. The right is reserved to order the removal of any animal deemed dangerous or out of control.
- b. Those in charge of exhibits will be subject to the orders and directions of the Chief Executive Officer, Stewards and Secretary. Exhibitors and their stock attendants will be expected to act with due courtesy at all times, and if guilty of improper behaviour before a Judge or at any other time, shall be liable to disqualification of all entries and withdrawal of prizes won.
- c. Stock attendants must be present each day of the Show and be available at least half an hour before the time appointed for the examination, judging or parade of the animals under their charge. No person will be allowed to take any animal from its standing or pen except for the aforesaid purposes and no rug or cloth shall be hung up or allowed to remain up so as to conceal any animal during the time the Show is open to the public without special permission of the Steward of the Department.

22. DEPARTURE OF EXHIBITS & REMOVAL ORDERS

- a. No livestock may be removed from its place on the Showground before the authorised time of departure stated beneath the Breed and Section headings in the Prize Schedule, without the special permission of the Chairman of the Executive or Secretary in writing. This will be given, normally only on a certificate from one of the Association Veterinary Inspectors, stating that it is desirable that the animals should be removed on veterinary grounds. Where stock is removed before the appointed time the Association reserves the right to withhold payment of Prize Money and to refuse entries for future shows.

23. ADMISSION TICKETS AND INSTRUCTIONS

- a. Free admission tickets in appropriate numbers will be issued to exhibitors and their stock attendants on the Showground in charge of livestock. These tickets (which are not transferable) and for which the exhibitor will be held responsible for the proper use, will be sent to the exhibitor with instructions before the Show.
- b. **In the case of transfer, or other improper use, the exhibitor will be dealt with under Regulation 25 (Penalties etc).**

24. RESPONSIBILITY, ETC.

- a. **The Association, its officers or staff shall not be responsible for any person while on the Association's Showground or Car Parks or while entering or leaving. Nor for any damage or loss, however caused, to the property, livestock, or of any person or for any injury, fatal or otherwise. The Association will not be held responsible for actions, suits, expenses, and claims on account of damage or injury which may be caused.**
- b. Exhibitors shall be held responsible for the behaviour of their stock attendants, the consequences of any negligence or misconduct and for any penalties imposed. Each exhibitor shall be solely responsible for any loss, injury, or damage that may be done to or arising from any livestock, article or property exhibited or brought on to the Showground.
- c. **Exhibitors are advised to insure against fire and other appropriate risks; not only their own property but also against third party claims.**
- d. The use of Trailers, Horseboxes and other vehicles as sleeping accommodation is not authorized unless vehicles are fitted for this purpose.

25. PENALTIES, RECOVERY OF FINES ETC.

- a. Any infringement of these Regulations shall be dealt with by the Council or, with the authority of that body, by its Chief Executive Officer, and may result in a fine up to £100 for each infringement. All fines, fees, and charges shall be recoverable by the Secretary, and until payment is made, persons owing them shall be prohibited from exhibiting at the Association's Shows.
- b. All people, livestock and articles entering the Showground or Car Parks shall be subject to the orders, rules and regulations of the Council and of any officer appointed by them. The Stewards have power to order any livestock, article or person who does not conform to the regulations of the Association or the directions of the Stewards, to leave or to be taken from the Showground or Car Park.
- c. The Association reserves the right to interpret these or any other prescribed conditions and regulations and settle and determine all matters, questions, or differences connected with the Shows. The right is also reserved to postpone or abandon the Show, and relax conditions or regulations, as the Association may deem expedient.
